

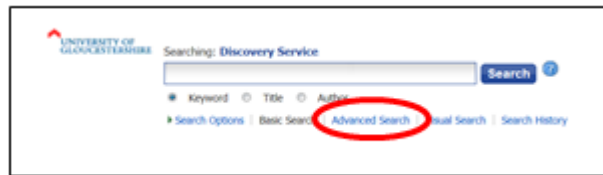
## How to use Discovery Service to find journal articles

1. From the Library web page <https://infonet.glos.ac.uk/DEPARTMENTS/LIS> select **Discovery Service** from the column on the left of the screen

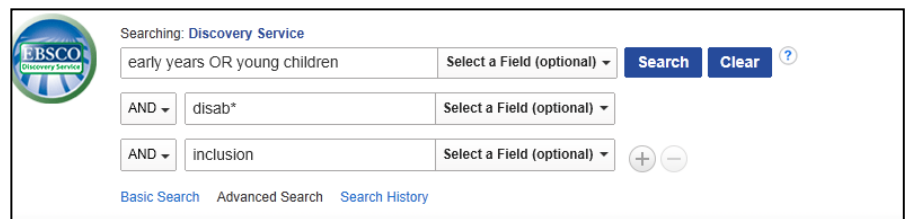


2. If you are off-campus log-in using your usual UoG username and password

3. Select **Advanced Search**



4. Enter your search terms and click on search



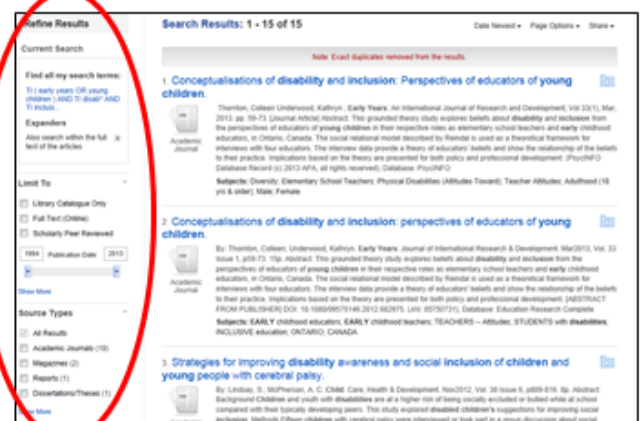
### Search Tips

- **Truncation** use \* - eg disab\* will find disabled, disability, disabilities
- **Proximity** searching use N - eg autism N3 inclusion will find records where the term autism appears within 3 words of the term autism
- Use **quote marks** for exact phrases eg "autistic spectrum disorder"

5. **Refine** your search by using the limiters on the left of the screen.

Limit by:

- Unchecking search within the Full-text
- Articles available in Full-text
- Peer reviewed
- Year of publication
- Academic Journals



## 6. Search results

Many of the articles will be available as **pdfs**.  
Simply click on the pdf to open it.

Other articles may have a **FindIt** icon. Use this to find out if the article is available.

There may also be some **Linked Full Text** articles which will open the article in a different database.
